ECO - CONFERENCE® : MOTIVES

The Resolution of Eco-Conference® in 1995 stated that the scientific-professional Conference on environmental protection of urban and suburban settlements would be organized in Novi Sad every odd year.

The organizer was motivated by the fact that the industrial development and intensive urbanization have not been accompanied by rational use of natural resources or protection of the environment. The initial idea was that Eco-Conference® should become a traditional meeting of scientists and professionals who would contribute to solutions of various environmental problems by presenting and exchanging experiences, opinions and ideas.

In order to complete the general goals of the conference programme, the complementary Eco-Conference® on safe food has been organized in even years starting from 2000.

From 2007, the Eco-Conference® has a purely scientific character, as decided by the Programme Council of the Ecological Movement of Novi Sad, as its organizer.

ECO - CONFERENCE® : OBJECTIVES

The Eco-Conference® is organized in order to:

- Provide objective views (avoiding under - or overestimating) on causes/agents contributing to environmental disbalance and levels of ecological threats to urban and suburban environment.
- Provide valuable information-communication basis for developing mid-term and long-term strategic programmes for: (a) integral environment protection, (b) commodity quality protection, (c) assessment of life quality and (d) promoting and supporting the concept and practice of sustainable development.

Consequently, each Eco-Conference® is a multi-dimensional event, in which scientists and experts of various profiles present and discuss numerous aspects of living and working conditions.

ECO - CONFERENCE® : THEMATIC SCOPE

Papers submitted for the Eco-Conference® may target any topic within the Conference's general thematic framework:

a) Physical components of urban environment related to places of work, residence and recreational activities:

- Air, water, soil, biosphere
- Noise, vibrations, radiation, light.

b) Social components of urban environment:

- Socio-economic position, security, employment, civil rights concerning work, education, retirement
- Cultural-spiritual values, heritage, traditional crafts
- Security challenges and community support to the family as the basic social unit.

In respect of the industrial civilization expansion, intense urbanization, demographic changes, economic turbulence in transitional societies, the Eco-Conference® focuses on causes and consequences of environmental degradation, as well as on protection measures, resources and activities, improvements and good practices.

The general thematic framework stresses the fact that there are no borders preventing the chain-effects of environmental degradation and also covers the problems related to processing industries (chemical, oil, textile, leather, metal, cellulose...).

All papers are subject to reviews.

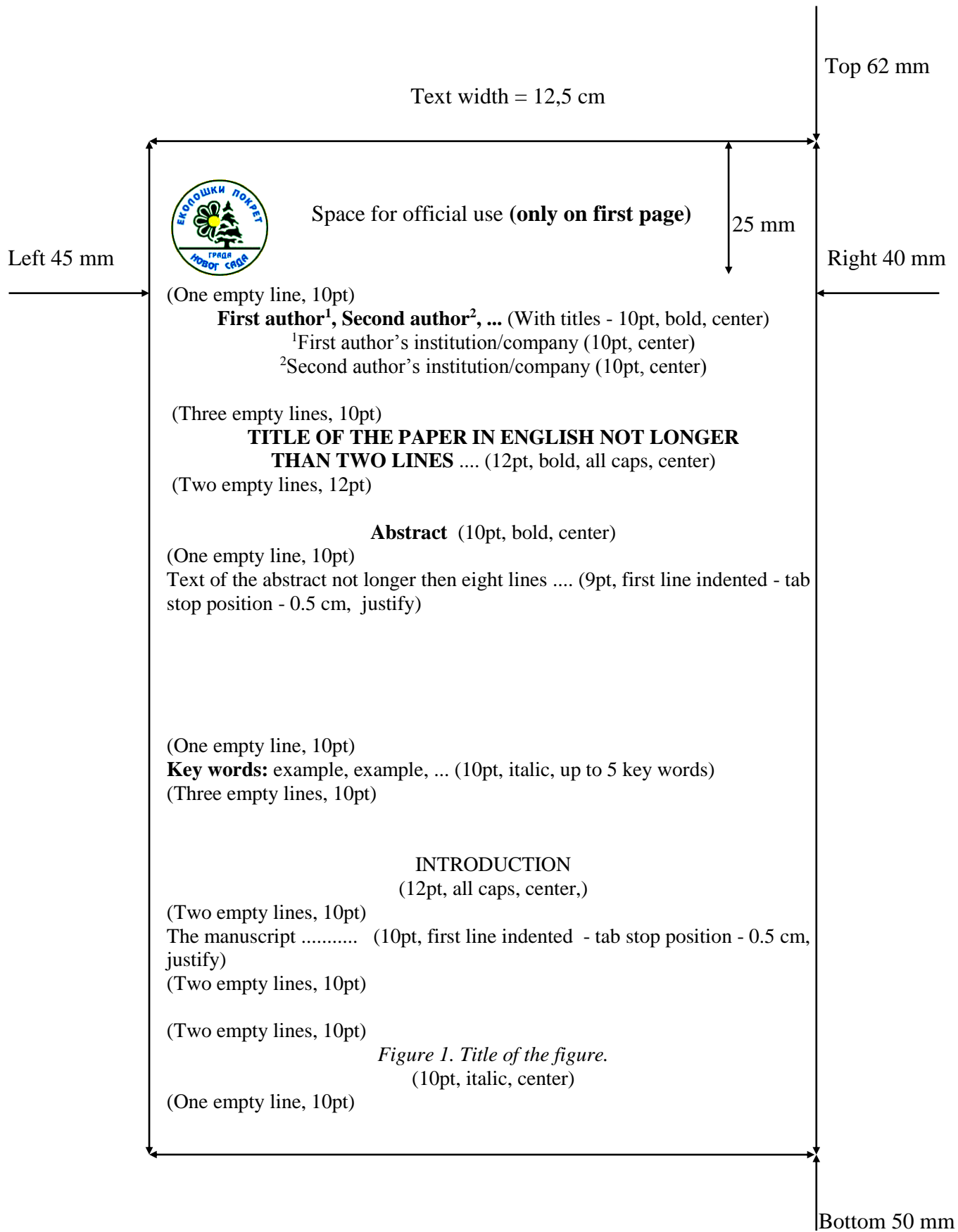
Papers should be sent to the organiser's E-mail address, with confirmed receipt.

INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC ECO-CONFERENCE®

Eco-conference® is a unique scientific conference held in Novi Sad since 1995. It received international status since 2003, and purely scientific character and sponsorship of the United Nations received since 2007.

The main organizer is the Ecological Movement of the city of Novi Sad, a renowned non-governmental environmental organization and the co-organizers are:

- University of Novi Sad, Serbia
- International Independent Ecological–Political University, Moscow, Russia
- State Agrarian University-Moscow Timiryazev Agricultural Academy, Russia
- Institute for Field and Vegetable Crops - Novi Sad, Serbia
- Institute for Food Technology in Novi Sad, Serbia
- Legambiente, National Ecological Organization, Italy.
- Institute of Lowland Forestry and Environment Novi Sad

Traditional Eco-conference® patron is Matica Srpska, together with United Nations (2007-2011) through its relevant organizations such as UNESCO and UN FAO.

Eco-conference® is traditionally held in the last full week of September, from Wednesday to Saturday, with daily supporting cultural events.

In odd years (1995, 1997, 1999, 2001, 2003, 2005, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2013 and 2015) theme of Eco-Conference® is "**Environmental protection of the cities and suburban settlements**", which is divided into the following sessions:

1. PARTS OF THE ENVIRONMENT: Air, water, soil and biosphere
2. TECHNICAL AND TECHNOLOGICAL ASPECTS OF PROTECTION
(Environmental Engineering)
3. SOCIAL, HEALTH, CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL AND RECREATIONAL ASPECTS OF PROTECTION
4. ECONOMIC ASPECTS OF PROTECTION
5. LEGAL ASPECTS OF PROTECTION
6. ECOLOGICAL SYSTEM DESIGN
(Informatics and other computer applications of integrated environmental protection)
7. SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT OF URBAN AND SUBURBAN SETTLEMENTS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECTS

In even years (2000, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2010, 2012, 2014, 2016) theme of Eco-Conference® is "**Healthy safe food**", which is divided into the following sessions:

1. Climate from the point of healthy safe food production
2. Soil and water as the basis for agricultural production of healthy safe food
3. Genetics, genetic resources, breeding and genetic engineering in the function of healthy safe food production
4. Fertilizers and fertilization in production of healthy safe food
5. Integrated plants protection, pesticides application and effects of residues
6. Agricultural production from sustainable development aspect
7. Production of field and vegetable crops from the point of healthy safe food
8. Fruit and grapes production from the standpoint of healthy safe food
9. Livestock production from the standpoint of healthy safe food
10. Application of food technology in the production of healthy safe food
11. Economic standpoint of healthy safe food production and marketing
12. Storage, transportation and packaging of healthy safe food
13. Nutritional value and high quality nutrition by healthy safe food
14. Legal aspects of healthy safe food products protection
15. Ecological models and software in the production of healthy safe food.

Since 2007, the Eco-Conference® excludes professional and includes only scientific papers and becomes an international scientific conference. Papers are accepted in English only on a halfway of author's sheet (8 pages B5 size) and published in

English in complete form in the Proceedings and during the working part are presented orally in English and Serbian, with simultaneous translation.

Eco-Conference[®] fulfilled the requirements of the Rulebook for scientific conferences and the Scientific Committee of the Ministry of Education and Science in 2008 appointed Eco-conference[®] to international scientific status.

In addition to Matica Srpska, the United Nations Organization for Education, Science and Culture (UNESCO) from 2007 up to 2011 and United Nations Organization for Food and Agriculture (UNFAO) from 2008 up to 2011 was Eco-conference[®] patron. Thus, Eco-conference[®] for the fifth time in a row received the patronage of the United Nations, which certified the international scientific importance and reputation of Eco-conference[®], classifying it in the world's scientific heritage.
